If you are interested in making a project at Run Amok, please submit your proposal either in English or Bahasa Malaysia, following the guideline below.

- Artist(s) bio
- Artist(s) CV
- Selected artwork images (10-15 max); please supply link to video works.
- Project description (100-250 words)
- Installation plan (if applicable, *refer to Run Amok floor plan)
- Equipment needed (any AV equipment or customised exhibition unit, etc.)
- Preferred time slot. (typically each slot is over 3 weeks period)
- Funding (is this a self-funded project or is there any third party funding)
- Is there any supporting programme?
- Support needed from Run Amok (curatorial assistance, promotion etc.)
- Why do you choose to exhibit in George Town, Penang and why Run Amok Gallery?

Our main objective is to provide an exhibition platform for artists and cultural events which are relevant to current socio-political conditions.

Run Amok is an art collective run by individuals who have other on-going practices. These project proposal guidelines are structured to allow effective communication between the Run Amok collective members and applicants. It should be treated as a general guideline, applicants are welcome to supply any other relevant materials that he/she thinks will help to articulate his / her idea better.

We aim to provide response to every complete proposal within two weeks. We look forward to receiving your proposal.

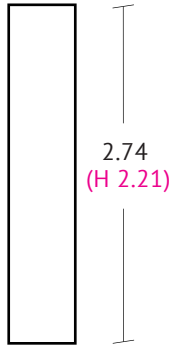

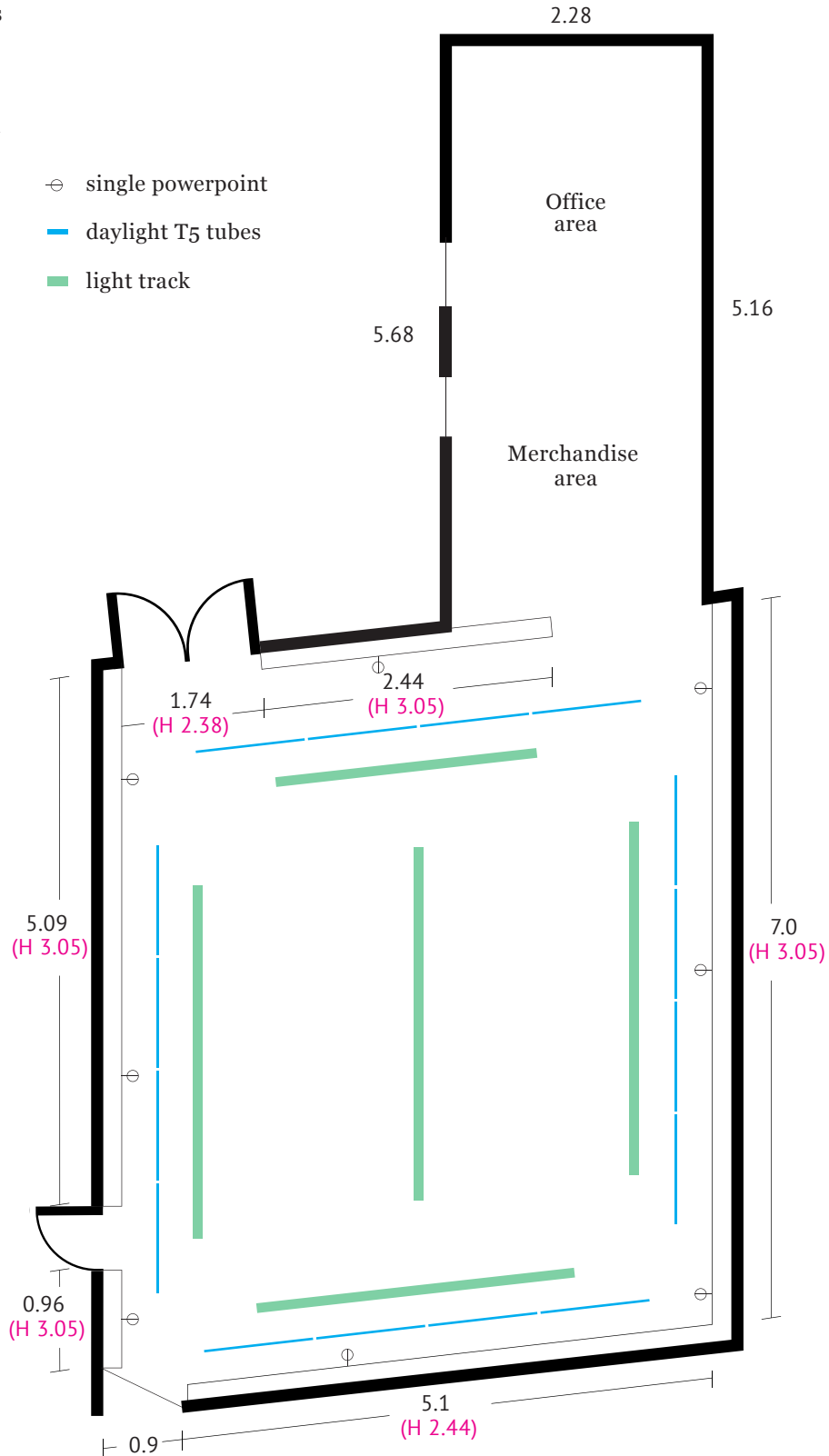
